Funding Update from Bridgend Farmhouse Chair

Dear Friends and Supporters,

We have received many kind and supportive messages over the past few weeks. The news that we are no longer to receive Scottish Government 'Investing in Communities' funding has come as a major blow. Bridgend Farmhouse's plight has been discussed in the Scottish Parliament and a motion of support was passed by the City of Edinburgh Council. We have been visited by MSPs, MPs and Councillors. We will continue to vigorously lobby for the ICF decision to be reversed and we have been informed we are on the funding reserve list which gives us some hope.

Our focus is on keeping the doors open at Bridgend Farmhouse to ensure our many activities, volunteer opportunities, community events, gardening, community café and venue spaces continue to be available to the local community. Every week we are submitting new funding applications and looking at ways of generating more income. With this in mind, I would be grateful if you would read through '7 Ways to Help Bridgend Farmhouse' on the back page of this newsletter. Come and have a meal in our wonderful community café, hold an event in one of our venue spaces, sponsor a fundraising event, get your bike serviced here or buy homemade jams, chutneys or a Bridgend Bear at one of our Monthly Markets.
